Since the XXIth century, migrations have taken a global turn, underlying the interdependency of migration topics with international issues. Although the main factors of migrations are root causes at world size, many political entrepreneurs and immigration policies are proposing another discourse, stressing on the Nation State as the main actor able to manage migration flows and to propose ethnic and religious challenges to be substituted to social issues.
