SCHOLARSHIPS FOR LOW-INCOME STUDENTS/STUDENTS IN FINANCIAL DIFFICULTIES

■ Stiftung Studienfonds OWL

Social scholarship for students with personal and financial need or in cases of emergency. Their academic achievements do not have priority. Support: 1000€/year, ideational support (contacts with local companies, workshops, seminars etc.) Application deadline: Summerterm: the end of February; Winterterm: the end of August, only in written form by post or by email. ■ International Office (Aid for Final Degree)

The object of these grants is to enable international students' preparation for final exams to be free of financial worries.

The following criteria are required:

- Financial need (e.g. if the student had to work in order to finance his/her studies)

- Good achievements in the course of studies so far

- A successful degree should be achieved within the next 6 months

- Endorsement through a professor's assessment

■ ViSiB and AStA (grants in financial emergencies)

ViSiB and AStA give out grants in cases of financial emergency to students who unexpectedly and without any fault of their own have encountered financial difficulties. SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CERTAIN GROUPS

■ Bafög (Federal Education and Training Assistance Act) support

Foreign students can be eligible to Bafög only in exceptional cases, e.g. when:

- at least one of their parents has German citizenship,
- they have or had a German spouse,
- they are asylum seekers, stateless foreigners or refugees,
- one of their parents have worked in Germany for six years before the beginning of their studies or
- they had worked in Germany for five years before the beginning of their studies.

■ Dr. Willy-Rebelein Stiftung (scholarships for students with disabilities and chronic conditions)

This foundation supports students with disabilities and chronic conditions in need. Application deadline: anytime. Financial support: 300€/month. ■ DAAD

Scholarships of the DAAD for studies in the Federal Republic of Germany can only be applied from the foreign student's homeland, if necessary in the very first months of the study stay in Germany. Normally, the student must have already achieved and provide proof of an undergraduate degree. You can receive further information at the embassy or consulate general. ■ German National Academic Foundation

For students with outstanding academic achievements and social and political commitment. Admission into the German National Academic Foundation is limited to students with German citizenship, students with a European Union nationality studying at a German university, or students of other nationalities with the German Abitur and studying at a German university. Support: 300€/month, ideational support (summer academies, personal attention etc.) Application deadline: January (students in their first or second term may apply for the scholarship) Further information: www.studienstiftung.de

■ Stiftung Studienfonds OWL

Merit-based scholarship (Germany Scholarship). Support: 300€/month, ideational support (contacts with local companies, workshops, seminars etc.) Application deadline: according to experience March/April, please have a look at the homepage of the foundation, only application via online portal possible.
